The Youth/Junior Programs are an integral part of the Grange and provide training in citizenship, responsibility and cooperation. Because individual conduct and appearance is a part of this training, it becomes the responsibility of all participating in a Grange activity to adhere to the Code of Conduct from the time they depart home until they return. Attendance and participation in State, Regional or National Grange activities and conventions is a privilege. Knowing any organization is judged largely by the behavior and appearance of its individuals participating, the following Code of Conduct is subscribed to for Youth members and chaperons/adults.

1. All participants will be expected to always be in attendance at the scheduled conference sessions and/or activities. (Prior approval of chaperon is required for any exceptions.)
2. Appropriate dress is expected while attending all conference sessions and/or activities.
3. No ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR ILLEGAL DRUGS in any form shall be possessed or used at any time or under any circumstances on public or private properties. Smoking during conference activities, events will not be permitted.
5. Curfew regulations shall be interpreted to mean that each member shall be in, and remain in, their assigned room 15 minutes after the last scheduled activity. Chaperons and scheduled activities may require adjustment of the curfew regulation as the situation warrants. 10:00 p.m. shall be the curfew time when other factors are not present.
6. You are not permitted to have the opposite sex in your room unless the door and window shades are open.
6. Members attending Grange conventions and/or activities are guests using the facilities. Special care shall be taken not to deface or destroy property. Any damage to any properties or furnishings in rooms or other facilities will be paid for by the individual.
7. Members participating in the activity are under the direct supervision of their State Youth Director or State Master.

It is agreed that upon violation the Code of Conduct, the violator(s) may be asked to leave the conference/activity by proper Grange authorities, the Youth Director or State Master. Serious misconduct will be reported to parents. Serious misconduct will result in the member being sent home. If the parents/guardian can't transport the youth member home within a reasonable time upon notification of expulsion, the member shall be sent home on public transportation at the cost of the member/parent/guardian.
