Threshold Requirements:

Impact on the organization: *Instrumental in the origins, growth, success and evolution of the Grange, including the fraternal aspects. Impact needs to extend beyond the county level, i.e., the nominee's contribution was recognized beyond his/her local area. Longevity as a member of the Grange is not sufficient as the sole factor for consideration in the Hall of Fame.*

Impact on the community/state/nation/world: *Instrumental in making the world a better place on a small or large scale. Contributions may be in public service, military, government, science, the arts & humanities or business. The requirements necessitate a level of uniqueness, for instance, being in the military or government with honorable, but not distinguished accomplishments is not sufficient.*

In addition, nominees should be no longer living.

Examples of individuals meeting threshold requirements:

Dudley W. Adams, first Master of the Iowa State Grange, Master of the National Grange and first delegate to the National Grange convention.

Thomas A. Thompson, second Master of the Minnesota State Grange and author of the original Secret Work.

Franklin D. & Eleanor Roosevelt, President & First Lady of the United States.

Dora H. Stockman, Michigan State Lecturer and founder of Four Leaf Clover Clubs for rural children (one of several 4-H precursor organizations).
